Clive has a strong entrepreneurial background, having been a main force behind the success of Software Warehouse in the 1990s, a founder of jungle.com in 1999, and he created the UK's first online karaoke service, Sing To The World in 2001. In 2002 Clive was a founder of the business that went on to become the UK's first falling price jewellery only TV shopping channel, Gems TV. Quickly an international success, Gems TV floated on the Singapore Stock Exchange in November 2006.

During 2006 he wrote his first book, POP Success. For legal reasons connected with Gems TV, this self-help title cannot be published until later 2007. But it was through the cartooning knowledge that Clive amassed while illustrating his own book that he got hooked on cartooning and the long-form comic book format called the Graphical Novel. This interest, coupled with his love for classical literature and a desire to make the world a better place culminated in the business idea that became Classical Comics.

Clive is hugely enthusiastic about anything that he does, but Classical Comics hits a special mark. "Classical Comics provide a way that we can teach classical literature to a modern audience, regardless of age. These stories are timeless, and if we can especially reach out to the kids of today, then maybe we can make the world a better place by giving them a love for literacy and for education".

With an aim as high as that, it is clear that he is fully behind his latest venture.
